## WHAT IS CROSSING BORDERS? [501(c)(3) non-profit corporation, ID# 41-2203926]

Crossing Borders is a Christian-based program that brings people together from across the U.S. (and beyond) to do mission work of mercy across the border in Mexico.

Attendees at the camp spend their days in direct contact with children and families who are lacking basic necessities. We visit orphanages and feed, teach and play with the kids (with dramas, puppets, songs, etc.). We perform “feedings” for the public—cooking and serving food in poor neighborhoods. We take used clothes to the people, distribute bulk food out of warehouses to the needy, and help with repairs of facilities. We touch needy people directly with our resources, and it changes and improves lives.

### Will you help make a transforming difference in the lives of many needy people?

The person giving you this letter will be personally involved in Crossing Borders mission work, and we’re asking for your help with resources we can invest into people’s lives. Of course, we’re always willing to accept a cash/check donation and we’ll purchase needed supplies. But we also look for in-kind donations of items that we distribute during our mission work. The list below gives a general idea of items we can use.

- Coloring books, crayons, markers, pens, construction paper, poster board, art supplies, scissors, paper, notebooks, scotch tape, other school and art supplies.
- Toys such as stuffed animals, small cars, dolls, simple games, Frisbees, balls of all kinds, play-dough, hula-hoops, jump ropes, soap bubbles—any toys for kids.
- Sox (for any ages), underwear (for kids)—[better to have these new than used].
- Hair clips, deodorant, hand sanitizer, toothbrushes, toothpaste, combs, soap, hairbrushes, caps, sunglasses, perfume, washcloths, towels, other toiletries.
